- I'm throwing up or have diarrhea.
- My eyes are pink and crusty.

### **Call the doctor if...**

- I have a temperature higher than 100 degrees for more than two days.
- I've been throwing up or have diarrhea for more than two days.
- I've had the sniffles for more than a week, and they aren't getting better.
- I still have asthma symptoms after using my asthma medicine (call 911 if I'm still having trouble breathing after using an inhaler).
