The Staff at Borchardt works hard to plan activities that engage and motivate our Borchardt Bears to attend school every day. Below is a snapshot of the fun activities and programs our teachers and staff implement throughout the year:

Lifeskills

Students earn "lifeskills" for following the "Bear Essentials" and demonstrating good character. Lifeskills are drawn for students to receive a prize. All lifeskills are placed in the Honey Pot. When the Honey Pot is full, the whole school will earn an extra recess.

Friday Roar

Each week, students who demonstrate excellence in academics, behavior, or social skills will receive a "Shout Out" during morning announcements.

Technology, Homework, & Academic Night

Teachers present to parents how to support their child with homework and academic success through the use of chromebooks and programs used in our classrooms.

Golden Lunch Ticket

Each class works to earn a ticket for following the "Bear Essentials" in the cafeteria during lunch. Classes earn tickets for cleanliness, noise level, and teamwork. Grade levels who fill their baskets with tickets will be rewarded with a privilege.

Running of the Bears

Classes who demonstrate the most school spirit and highest percentage of attendance earn the great honor of "Running with the Bears." Borchardt Bears line the halls and clap and cheer to music as the winning classes run through!

1st & 2nd Semester Awards Assembly

An Awards Assembly is held at the end of each semester for students in grades K-6 to celebrate academic achievement, lifeskills, and perfect attendance.

Every day Counts Attendance Incentive Award

Students who attend school every day receive free passes to a UOP basketball game and are entered in a drawing to win a Tablet.

Student Government

Students are in charge of passing Bills and organizing Noon League, Spirit Days, and other fun events.

Kindness Crew

The Borchardt Kindness Crew works each year to promote kindness throughout the school and community. Activities include: Welcoming of new students, welcoming Borchardt Bears to school each Wednesday with fist bumps and music, and organizing a yearly kindness challenge for the Borchardt community.

Borchardt Newspaper

Sixth grade students produce a monthly Borchardt newspaper to be sold to our Borchardt students using Borchardt Bucks.

Yearbook

Students and staff work together throughout the year to develop our Borchardt Yearbook.

Quarterly Welcome Back Rallies

Teachers dress up to a theme and welcome back students to music. Teachers deliver lessons throughout the day to go along with the theme.

Math Olympiad

Students meet after school to practice solving rigorous mathematical word problems. They compete in the District Math Olympiad competition in the spring.

Krypto

Students in 5th and 6th grade compete in a Krypto tournament style competition three Fridays a week. This supports the practice of fact memorization and friendly competition.

Running Club

Students develop a greater interest in staying active and leading a healthy lifestyle. The running club trains with staff to prepare for the Lodi Unified School District Track Event held in the spring.

Spirit Days

Students bring on their school spirit through wearing Kindness Ninja shirts and college shirts on Wednesdays and Borchardt spirit shirts on Fridays. We also have monthly theme based spirit days sponsored by our Student Government. Attendance, Spirit, & Positive Behavior Competition flags are given to the classes who win.
